ORDINANCE NO. 318

An ordinance prohibiting the soliciting of orders for subscriptions to magazines, and prohibiting the taking of such orders, within the city limits of the city of Sumner, Illinois, by itinerant salesmen, without first having obtained a license to do so from the city clerk of said city.

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Sumner, Illinois, in meeting duly assembled.

Section 1: That for the purposes of this Ordinance the soliciting of orders for subscriptions to magazines shall be defined as the endeavoring on the part of an itinerant salesman, as such is hereinafter defined, to obtain orders from citizens and residents of the City of Sumner, Illinois, for the taking of subscriptions to magazines, either directly by personal contact or by telephone.

SECTION 2: That an itinerant salesman, for the purposes of this Ordinance, is defined as being a person, firm or corporation who solicits orders for magazine subscriptions within the corporate limits of the City of Sumner, Illinois, without having an office or place of business located within

the City Limits of the City of Sumner, Illinois, which is of a permanent nature, and which has been located within the corporate limits of said City for more than ninety (90) consecutive days prior to the solicitation of orders for subscriptions to magazines or the taking of such orders.

SECTION 3: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation coming within the definition of an itinerant salesman, as hereinabove set out, to solicit orders for magazine subscriptions from any person or other subject within the corporate limits of the City of Sumner, Illinois, without said itinerant salesman first having obtained a license as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 4: Such license shall be obtained from the City Clerk of the City of Sumner, Illinois, and shall be issued by him upon the filing with him of an application for such license upon a form to be submitted by him to the applicant, and upon payment to him by applicant of the sum of \$50.00 per day for each day applicant proposes to solicit orders for magazine subscriptions within the City of Sumner, Illinois.

SECTION 5: Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined, upon conviction of such violation, a sum not to exceed \$200.00. Each day that such violation continues shall be considered as a separate offense and an additional fine shall be assessed and collected therefor.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, approval by the Mayor of said City, and publication as provided by law.
