BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL of the City of Sumner, Lawrence County, Illinois, that Ordinance No. 457 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Sumner, Lawrence County, Illinois, entitled "INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLES", shall be amended to add Section 6.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 6:

PENALTY:

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$75.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each such violation, and each day such violation shall continue more than (10) days after the date of written notice given, pursuant to Section 4 hereof, shall constitute a separate offense hereunder.

Upon passage and approval, this Amendment to the Ordinance shall take effect and be effective ten days after publication as provided by law. Should any section or provision of this Amendment to the Ordinance be declared invalid by a Court of law, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.
