

ORDINANCE NO. 471

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 236

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE POOL HALLS,  
ARCADES, OR AMUSEMENT CENTERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF the City of  
Sumner, Lawrence County, Illinois:

For the purpose of this ordinance Pool Halls, Arcades, or  
Amusements Centers are those businesses which provide pool  
tables, video games, or other mechanical devises for the  
enjoyment of other.

**SECTION ONE:**

That any person, firm, corporation, or organization who  
shall own, operate, maintain, or manage any pool hall, arcade,  
or amusement center for gain or hire shall pay a license fee of  
\$25.00 per year per table, arcade game, video game or mechanical  
devises.

**SECTION TWO:**

No owner, or operator, who owns or manages a pool hall,  
arcade, or amusement center, shall allow alcoholic beverages on  
the premises for sale or consumption.

**SECTION THREE:**

All pool halls, arcades, or amusement centers shall be  
closed at 12:00 midnight on each day and remain closed until  
7:00 a.m. of the next day and no minor under the age of sixteen  
(16) years shall be permitted to play upon said pool tables  
without the consent of a parent or guardian of said minor.

**SECTION FOUR:**

Any person, firm, corporation or organization violating any Section of this ordinance may be fined not less than SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$75.00), nor more than FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) and a separate offense shall be deemed to occur on each day or on which a violation occurs or continues.

**SECTION FIVE:**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be effective from the date of its passage as provided by law.
