ORDINANCE NO. 487

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE DESIGNATION OF
SNOW ROUTES IN THE CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SUMNER, ILLINOIS, that:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be effective from the date of its passage provided by law.

The following streets are hereby designated as snow routes:

- (1) Christy Avenue;
- (2) Cedar Street;
- (3) Walnut Street.

After notice by local media that a two inch snowfall has accumulated in Lawrence County, there shall be no parking on either side of the streets designated snow routes until such time that notice is given that parking may be resumed. This City is hereby authorized at the beginning of any two hour period after at least two inches of snowfall has accumulated to remove snow on such snow routes and to tow vehicles which may be parked thereon in violation of this Ordinance.

Vehicles parking on snow routes in violation of this Ordinance shall be towed and may be reclaimed upon payment of towing and storage fees, if any.


