AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORIES
TO THE CITY OF SUMNER, LAWRENCE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Adopted by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sumner this 8th day of January, 2002.

WHEREAS written Petitions signed by the legal owners of record of a portion of land within a territory hereinafter described has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Sumner, Lawrence County, Illinois, requesting that said territory be annexed to the City of Sumner pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/7-1-8; copies of the Petitions are attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution entitled, "Resolution No. 2001-516, A Resolution to Annex Property Owned by the State of Illinois and known as Lawrence Correctional Center to the City of Sumner" has been previously passed and approved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Sumner for the purposes of annexing the territory owned by the State of Illinois and known as the Lawrence Correctional Center, and which Resolution has been approved by the Governor of the State of Illinois pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/7-1-2(f), which territory represents a portion of the territory hereinafter described to be annexed; a copy of which Resolution is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, the electors residing within the said territory are the owners of record of same and are also all the electors residing therein; and

WHEREAS, said territory is not within the corporate limits of any municipality but is contiguous to the City of Sumner; and

WHEREAS, legal notices regarding intention of the City of Sumner to annex said territory have been sent to all public bodies required to receive such notice by statute; and

WHEREAS, copies of such notices required to be recorded, if any, have been recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds, Lawrence County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, all Petitions, documents and other necessary legal requirements are in full compliance with the terms of the statute of State of Illinois, specifically 65 ILCS 5/7-1-2(f) and 7-1-8; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Sumner that said territory be annexed thereto,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMNER, LAWRENCE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the following described territory:

Tract 1: The Northwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 3 North, Range 13 West of the Second Principal Meridian; EXCEPT a tract granted to the State of Illinois for Highway purposes; EXCEPT, also a tract commencing at the Northwest Corner of said Section 6, thence South parallel with the West line of Section 6, 30 feet to the South right of way of U.S. Route #50, thence East along the South right of way line of U.S. Route #50 1,465 feet to the point of beginning; thence South parallel with the West line of Section 6, 559 feet, thence East parallel with the North line of Section 6, 391 feet, thence North parallel with the West line of Section 6, 559 feet, said point located on the South right of way of U.S. Route #50, thence West along said right of way line of U.S. Route #50, 391 feet to the point of beginning.

Tract 2: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of Section 6, Township 3 North, Range 13 West of the Second Principal Meridian, thence South parallel with the West line of Section 6, 30 feet to the South right of way of U.S. Route #50, thence East along the South right-of-way line of U.S. Route #50, 1,465 feet to the point of beginning; thence South parallel with the West line of Section 6, 559 feet, thence East parallel with the North line of Section 6, 391 feet, thence North parallel with the West line of Section 6, 559 feet, said point located on the South right of way of U.S. Route #50, thence West along said right of way line of U.S. Route #50, 391 feet to the point of beginning.

Tract 3: The fractional West Half of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, lying North of the right-of-way of B & O Railroad, containing 37 acres; situated in Township 3 North of Range 13 West of the Second Principal Meridian, situated in the County of Lawrence, State of Illinois.

Tract 4: Beginning approximately 168.5 feet South of the Northeast Corner of Section 8, Township 3 North, Range 13 West, 2nd Principal Meridian, being the intersection of the East line of Section 8 and the North right of way line of B&O Railroad, thence Northwesterly approximately 5,370 feet along the North right of way line of B&O Railroad to the West line of Section 5, Township 3 North, Range 13 West, 2nd P.M., thence Northerly 25 feet along West line of said Section 5, thence Northwesterly approximately 1,350 feet along the North right of way line of B&O Railroad, thence Southerly 25 feet, thence Northwesterly approximately 640 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Northerly 25 feet, thence Northwesterly 600 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Southerly 25 feet, thence Northwesterly 89 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Northerly 25 feet, thence Northwesterly approximately 680 feet along said

Railroad right of way, thence Southerly 25 feet, thence Northwesterly approximately 618.5 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Southerly 100 feet to the South right of way line of B&O Railroad, thence Southeasterly approximately 599 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Southerly 25 feet, thence Southeasterly approximately 700 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Northerly 25 feet, thence Southeasterly 87 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Southerly 25 feet, thence Southeasterly 600 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Northerly 25 feet, thence Southeasterly approximately 645 feet along said Railroad right of way, thence Southerly 25 feet, thence Southeasterly approximately 1,150 feet to the South line of Section 6, Township 3 North, Range 13 West, 2nd P.M., thence Easterly approximately 200 feet along South line of said Section 6, thence Northerly approximately 7.5 feet along the East line of said Section 6, thence Southeasterly approximately 5,370 feet along the South right of way line of B&O Railroad to the East line of Section 8, Township 3 North, Range 13 West, 2nd P.M., thence North 100 feet to the point of beginning, containing 24.45 acres, more or less.

being indicated on an accurate map of the annexed territory which is appended to and made a part of this Ordinance is hereby annexed to the City of Sumner, Lawrence County, Illinois:

SECTION 2: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to record with the Recorder of Deeds and to file with the County Clerk a certified copy of this Ordinance, together with the accurate map of the territory annexed appended to said Ordinance.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
