

ORDINANCE NO. 584-A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 572 OF THE CITY OF SUMNER, ILLINOIS, TO INCREASE RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICES OF THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF SAID CITY TO USERS INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City of Sumner, Illinois (City) is a duly organized and existing municipality created under the provisions of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates a public water supply system; and

WHEREAS, the City has the power, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-125-3 to establish all necessary rules, regulations and rates for the use and maintenance of a public water supply system; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that there should be an amendment in the rates charged to users of the City's public water supply system inside and outside the corporation limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Sumner, Illinois:

Section 1. This Ordinance is intended to establish use and service rates for all users of the public water supply system inside and outside the corporate limits of the City of Sumner, Illinois, and shall be in addition to any connection fees or assessments provided in prior ordinances of the City.

Section 2. Section 8 of Ordinance 572 is hereby amended so that said section reads, as amended, as follows:

Section 8. WATER RATES. The following rates for the use and service supplied by the public water supply system shall be based upon the following amount of water consumed as follows:

(A) **Inside City.** The minimum charge per month for water service shall be \$17.50. The rate of water service per 1,000 gallons of water used as shown by meter readings shall be as follows:
First 1,000 gallons per month \$17.50 per 1,000 gallons
Each next 1,000 gallons thereafter \$6.50 per 1,000 gallons

(B) **Outside City.** The minimum charge per month for water service shall be \$26.25. The rate of water service per 1,000 gallons of water used as shown by meter readings shall be as follows:
First 1,000 gallons per month \$26.25 per 1,000 gallons
Each next 1,000 gallons thereafter \$7.50 per 1,000 gallons

(C) Temporary Surcharge. Each customer account shall be charged a monthly surcharge of \$5.25 for a term of three consecutive billing cycles commencing with the first monthly billing for services rendered after the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Except as provided herein, all other rates, rules, regulations and ordinances pertaining to the use of the City's public water supply system shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
