

ORDINANCE NO. 585

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 409 RELATING TO
DOGS AND CATS RUNNING AT LARGE WITHIN THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SUMNER, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMNER, ILLINOIS,
THAT:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Section Three of Ordinance No. 409, as heretofore amended, relating to dogs and cats running at large within the corporate limits of the City of Sumner, Illinois.

Section 2. Amendment. Section Three of Ordinance No. 409 is hereby amended so that said section, as amended, reads as follows:


SECTION THREE:

Any dog or cat found in the City of Sumner, Illinois, running at large, under conditions set forth in Sections 1 above, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and may be impounded by the Police Department. The owner of any dog or cat impounded under this Section may redeem said animal upon payment of a redemption fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00); it shall be the duty of the authorities to release the animal from the pound and deliver it to its owner, or certify the release thereof to any County authority having possession of the animal.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
