

ORDINANCE NO. 605

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING HIRING STANDARDS FOR
PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF SUMNER, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the City of Sumner, Illinois (City) is required to establish hiring standards for part-time police officers and submit those standards to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board, pursuant to Section 3.1-30-21 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-21); and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City desire to maintain compliance with the aforesaid statutory mandate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the corporate authorities of the City of Sumner, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Part-Time Police. The Mayor may, with the advice and consent of the City Council, appoint part-time police officers.

- (A) Duties. Part-time police officers shall have all of the responsibilities of a full-time police officer in such specific duties as set forth in the Policy Manual of the Police Department, but the number of hours a part-time officer may work within a calendar year is restricted. Part-time police officers shall not be assigned to supervise or direct full-time police officers, and shall not be used as permanent replacements for permanent full-time police officers.
- (B) Hiring Standards. Any person employed as a part-time police officer must meet the following standards:
1. Be at least twenty-one (21) years of age;
 2. Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate.
 3. Possess a valid driver's license issued by the State of Illinois.
 4. Have no prior felony convictions.
 5. If a veteran, have been honorably discharged.
 6. Be of good moral character, and physically and mentally capable of performing the assigned duties.
- (C) Training. All part-time police officers shall be required to enter and successfully complete a course on police procedure by the proper authorities as established by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board within the prescribed time as established

by such board, and shall otherwise successfully complete any other law enforcement training as may be mandated by the State of Illinois. Upon completion of the course of training, the officer shall file with the Mayor a certificate attesting to the completion of the required training.

- (D) Discipline. Part-time police officers may be disciplined by the Chief of Police. Part-time police officers serve at the discretion of the corporate authorities, and may be discharged at any time by the Mayor.

Section 2. Notice to Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board. The Chief of Police is hereby directed to furnish a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, phrase or part of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall not be impaired, and the application of those provisions to any person or circumstance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. Repeal. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
